

Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Bishop Sunland Solid Waste Site, Inyo County, SWIS No. 14-AA-0005

Action By: October 7, 2017

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Bishop Sunland Solid Waste Site, SWIS No. 14-AA-0005, located in Inyo County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was initially received on May 11, 2017. On June 27, 2017, the operator requested a 60-day waiver of the timelines to August 27, 2017. On June 29, 2017, the LEA accepted the timeline waiver and sent the approved request to CalRecycle. A new proposed permit was received on August 8, 2017. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than October 7, 2017. If no action is taken by October 7, 2017, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance staff report, I concur in the issuance of the Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Bishop Sunland Solid Waste Site, SWIS No. 14-AA-0005, as proposed.
