Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health, and Division of Environmental Health (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Advance Disposal Transfer/Processing Facility. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Determination

Advance Disposal is located approximately 1,400 feet east of Santa Fe Avenue East. The site is bounded on the north by Lilac Road and Darwin Avenue, on the east by E Avenue and G Avenue, on the south by Lemon

Street, and on the west by Santa Fe Avenue East. The site is located at 17105 Mesa Street in Hesperia, California. On September 15, 2017 the LEA received from Advance Disposal, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the RFI in order to update New Recycling/Transfer Equipment, reflect current Operator Information and Emergency Contacts, and for Accessors Parcel Number (APN) to reflect the combined properties that had taken place during the 2012 expansion project.

The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on October 10, 2017.
