The meeting process outlined above will be used for each Program Reform Focus Group Workshop and is designed to facilitate discussion and dialogue between CalRecycle and workshop attendees. The meeting process is designed to ensure discussion and dialogue and to use critical questioning to explore issues and refine ideas. It is a linear process. Program reform ideas will be discussed individually and in turn. When discussion and dialogue for a specific program reform idea is closed-out, the focus group will not return to that individual idea. During discussion on a program reform idea, there will be ample opportunity for all attendees to comment and ask questions.
