Monday 8/22 1-3pm	Coastal Hearing Room	<u>Thresholds</u>	Help CalRecycle determine relevant thresholds for having to report, reporting each material stream, for aggregating End User information, and for defining between the categories of mixed recyclables and mixed waste.
Monday 8/22 3-5pm	Coastal Hearing Room	<u>Organics management</u>	Requirements for composters and organics recyclers, including issues around anaerobic digesters, PTOWs, land application, and more.
Tuesday 8/23 9-10:30am	Sierra Hearing Room	<u>Penalties and enforcement procedures</u>	Procedures for determining violations, opportunities for remediation, and the application of penalties.
Tuesday 8/23 10:30a-12pm	Sierra Hearing Room	<u>Multiple Operations</u>	Reporting requirements for vertically integrated reporters, who collect, process and use the material; and how to report multiple recycling, composting and disposal activities at the same site.
Tuesday 8/23 1-3pm	Sierra Hearing Room	<u>Jurisdictional requests and confidentiality</u>	How local governments can interact with their disposal and recycling facilities and CalRecycle to provide accurate data; the kinds of data that will be available to jurisdictions and the public, and what will be confidential.
Tuesday 8/23 3-5pm	Sierra Hearing Room	<u>Methodologies for jurisdiction of origin and source sector</u>	Discussion on acceptable methods for acquiring the necessary information and acceptable ranges for accuracy. Participants are encouraged to share their current record keeping format to inform system development.
Wednesday 8/24 1-3pm	Coastal Hearing Room	<u>Targeted products and material types</u>	Discussion on the list of targeted products that CalRecycle intends to track, as well as explaining how material types are to be reported.
Wednesday 8/24 3-5pm	Coastal Hearing Room	<u>General Topics</u>	Discussion on any other topics not covered in the previous workshops, including the definition of End User, how CalRecycle envisions the mechanics of reporting, etc.
