The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Solid Waste Management Program, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), will be holding a Public Informational Meeting for a proposed new full solid waste facility permit. The LEA is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within its jurisdiction.

*Description of Project:* Allan Company is proposing to incorporate a Transfer/ Processing component into an existing heavy recycling processing facility within an existing 48,000 square foot building on 8.59 acres site located in an industrial zone in the City of Palmdale. Currently, the facility consist of a full service recycling center. It accepts and transports recyclables from residential, commercial, and industrial accounts to other facilities for processing. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was approved on September 11, 2014.

The proposed new permit would allow for:

- A maximum throughput of 750 tons per day of non-hazardous materials, including source separate recyclable material from curb-side collection programs, multifamily programs, commercial accounts or other recycling program, as well as residential, commercial, industrial mixed solid waste, food waste and construction and demolition (C&D) debris. Bulky items and other separated recyclables will also be accepted.
- Public hours: Monday – Friday between the hours of 6:30 A.M. – 5:30 P.M.; and 7:00 A.M.-3:00 P.M.on Saturday; Sunday closed.

*LEA's Determination:* Pursuant to Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27CCR), Section 21650, the LEA determined that the application package met the requirements of 27 CCR, Section 21570 and accepted the application for filing on December 12, 2015.

*Purpose of the Meeting:* The Public Information Meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the proposed permit and to provide comments to the LEA. The meeting is strictly informational and **no official decision will be made at the meeting** regarding the formal determination on the solid waste facility permit application.

*Where to Obtain Additional Information:* A copy of the permit application is available for public review by appointment only at the LEA office noted above between 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. Monday through Friday.
