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Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) for the East Valley Recycling and Transfer Facility. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The East Valley Recycling and Transfer Facility is located at 1150 & 1250, S. Tippecanoe Avenue, San Bernardino. On November 25, 2014 the LEA received, from East Valley Recycling and Transfer Facility, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the TPR to allow the direct transfer of non-processed C& D materials to offsite processing facilities from building 1150 and update equipment list. The changes include:

- Facility Overview
- General Design Requirements
- Table of Contents.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA Documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on November 25, 2014.
