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Please be advised that the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), acting as the Solid Waste Enforcement Agency (EA) for Stanislaus County, has received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment per Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665(c). This public notice was prepared pursuant to Title 27 CCR 21660.1.

**Project Description**

Fink Road Landfill is an existing solid waste disposal site operating under a full Solid Waste Facilities Permit issued on August 17, 2007. Changes made to the Report of Facility Information (RFI) include: an updated JTD to include all previously approved RFI Amendments; updated Table of Contents; update to site personnel; inclusion of wood material (compost overs) as ADC; inclusion of waste tires exceeding 499 for recycling; addition of mattress recycling; update in airspace, remaining site capacity, and estimated remaining excavated soil calculations; update to the estimated closure years for the Class II and Class III cells; and updates to tables and figures to incorporate the above changes.

The EA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
