The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP), acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within its jurisdiction.

The facility of Southern California Disposal Company Recycling and Transfer Station operates under a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) issued by the SWMP. The operator has filed an application for a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment with the SWMP. The RFI describes the design and operation of the facility.

### Description of Project

The operator submitted an application for an RFI amendment to update information in the Transfer/Processing Report (TPR) in regards to facility site plan and handling/processing of refuse.

### LEA's Determination

An application for RFI amendments was received by the SWMP on May 13, 2016. Pursuant to Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665 (c), the SWMP reviewed the application and determined that the proposed changes are consistent with all adopted CEQA documents, consistent with State Minimum Standards and do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current SWFP. The SWMP approved the RFI amendments on June 9, 2016.
