Please be advised that the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), acting as the Solid Waste Enforcement Agency (EA) for the Stanislaus County, has received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment per Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665(c). This public notice was prepared pursuant to Title 27 CCR 21660.1.

Project Description

Modesto Co-Compost Facility is an existing composting facility operating under a full Solid Waste Facilities Permit issued on March 29, 2011. The application package to amend the RFI requests the following changes: update to the current composting location and direction of windrows; addition of a new modular office building; addition of new equipment; updates to the Odor Impact Minimization Plan; inclusion of all dust control measures; and inclusion of a tree nursery and leaf corral.

The EA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
