

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## 12. Legal Description of Facility:

## 13. Findings:

- a. The location of the facility is identified in the Stanislaus County Non-Disposal Facility Element (NDFE). Stanislaus County adopted the NDFE in December 1994 and the Department (previously the California Integrated Management Board) approved the NDFE on May 23, 1995.
- b. This permit is consistent with the standards adopted by CalRecycle, pursuant to PRC 44010.
- c. The design and operation of the facility is consistent with the State Minimum Standards for Solid Waste Handling and Disposal as determined by the enforcement agency, pursuant to PRC 44009.
- d. The Modesto Fire Department has determined that the facility is in conformance with applicable fire standards, pursuant to PRC 44151.
- e. A Negative Declaration was filed with the State Clearinghouse (SCH # 2011082025) on August 8, 2011.

## 14. Prohibitions:

The permittee is prohibited from accepting the following wastes:

Hazardous, radioactive, medical (as defined in Title 22, Division 4, Section 117600-118360 of the Health and Safety Code), liquid, designated, or other wastes requiring special treatment or handling, except as identified in the Transfer Processing Report and approved amendments thereto and as approved by the enforcement agency and other federal, state, and local agencies.

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## 16. Self Monitoring:

The owner/operator shall submit the results of all self monitoring programs to the Enforcement Agency within 30 days of the end of the reporting period (*for example, 1<sup>st</sup> quarter = January – March, the report is due by April 30, etc.*).

e. Operator's actions taken to resolve any complaints.	Within 7 days of Complaint
f. Notification to the enforcement agency via telephone or electronic mail of any special occurrences, including but not limited to fires, explosions, earthquakes, significant injuries, accidents or property damage, and all measures taken to address the incident.	Within 24 hours of the Event

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## 17. Enforcement Agency (EA) Conditions:

- a. The operator shall comply with all State Minimum Standards for solid waste handling and disposal as specified in Title 14 CCR, Chapter 3.0 Division 7.
- b. The operator shall maintain a log of special/unusual occurrences. This log shall include, but is not limited to, operational shutdowns, fires, explosions, the discharge and disposition of hazardous or unpermitted wastes, and significant injuries, accidents or property damage. Each log entry shall be accompanied by a summary of any actions taken by the operator to mitigate the occurrence. The log shall be available to site personnel and the EA during operating hours.
- c. All loads entering the facility shall undergo load checking in a manner that meets the approval of the EA. Trained load checking personnel shall be on-site to verify that received loads do not contain prohibited wastes. Operator shall keep records of training and load checks performed to meet the requirements.
- d. Additional information concerning the design and operation of the facility shall be furnished upon request and within the time frame specified by the EA.
- e. The maximum permitted daily tonnage for this facility is 950 tons per day (tpd), and shall not receive more than this amount without a revision of this permit.
- f. This permit is subject to review by the EA and may be suspended, revoked, or revised at any time for sufficient cause.
- g. The EA reserves the right to suspend or modify waste receiving and handling operations when deemed necessary due to an emergency, a potential health hazard, or the creation of a public nuisance.
- h. Any change that would cause the design or operation of the facility not to conform to the terms and conditions of this permit is prohibited. Such a change may be considered a significant change, requiring a permit revision. In no case shall the operator implement any change without first submitting a written notice of the proposed change, in the form of an RFI amendment, to the EA at least 180 days in advance of the change.
- i. A copy of this permit and approved Transfer Processing Report and all EA approved RFI amendments shall be maintained at the facility and readily available to site personnel and the EA upon request.
