**Summary of Request:** This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed revised Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Alameda County Industries Transfer/Processing Facility, SWIS No. 01-AA-0290, located in the County of Alameda. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.


The proposed permit was received on August 10, 2011. New versions were received on November 17, 2011 and November 28, 2011. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than January 20, 2011. If no action is taken by January 20, 2011, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

**Recommendation:** Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Staff Report.
