**Summary of Request:** This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Robert A. Nelson Transfer Station & Materials Recovery Facility, SWIS No. 33-AA-0258, located in Riverside County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was initially received on February 21, 2012. New proposed permits were received on March 13, 2012 and April 26, 2012. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than June 25, 2012. If no action is taken by June 25, 2012, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

**Recommendation:** Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report.
