

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed revised Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Benton Crossing Sanitary Landfill, SWIS No. 26-AA-0004, located in Mono County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was received on January 15, 2013. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than March 16, 2013. If no action is taken by March 16, 2013, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.


Recommendation:

Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report.
