Decision Subject: Concurrence on Revised Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Mid Valley Disposal Recycling and Transfer Station, Fresno County, SWIS No. 10-AA-0201

Action By: April 5, 2014

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed revised Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Mid Valley Disposal Recycling and Transfer Station, SWIS No. 10-AA-00201, located in Fresno County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was initially received on November 20, 2013. The operator waived the statutory time line to provide additional information. A new proposed permit was received on February 4, 2014. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than April 5, 2014. If no action is taken by April 5, 2014, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance Staff Report, I concur in the issuance of the Revised Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Mid Valley Disposal Recycling and Transfer Station, SWIS No. 10-AA-0201, as proposed.
