Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Moreno Valley Solid Waste Recycling and Transfer Facility, Riverside County, SWIS No. 33-AA-0234

Action By: March 9, 2015

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed Revised Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Moreno Valley Solid Waste Recycling and Transfer Facility, located in Riverside County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The initial proposed permit was received on November 20, 2014. A new proposed permit was received on January 8, 2015. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than March 9, 2015. If no action is taken by March 9, 2015, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report, I concur in the issuance of the Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Moreno Valley Solid Waste Recycling and Transfer Facility, SWIS No. 33-AA-0234, as proposed.
