
Summary of Request: This is a request that the Department Director take action on a proposed Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Newby Island Sanitary Landfill, SWIS No. 43-AN-0003, located in the City of San Jose. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was received on December 9, 2014. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than February 7, 2015. If no action is taken by February 7, 2015, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Department Director concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685, have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report.

Department Director Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance staff report, I concur in the issuance of the Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Newby Island Sanitary Landfill, SWIS No. 43-AN-0003, as proposed.
