Background: The Athens Sun Valley facility has been operating as a construction and demolition and inert (CDI) debris processing facility at 11121 Pendleton, Sun Valley, California, 91352 since 2001. The facility is currently permitted to accept 400 tons of CDI debris under a temporary solid waste facility permit. The proposed design will be for a MRF/Transfer Station that will be permitted to accept 1,000 tons of municipal solid waste and 500 tons of CDI debris per day and will operate from 7 am to 8 pm, 7 days a week.

The Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), the City of Los Angeles Environmental Affairs Department has accepted the permit application package and has submitted a proposed permit for CalRecycle review and concurrence. The LEA held an informational meeting regarding this facility on May 10, 2010 at 6:30 pm at the John H. Francis Polytechnic High School Auditorium, 12431 Roscoe Blvd., Sun Valley, California 91352.

This meeting is open to all interested parties to ask questions and provide comments regarding the Athens Sun Valley MRF and CalRecycle's regulatory responsibility the processing of the large volume transfer/processing facility permit. All comments received during the informational meeting will be reviewed and considered by the LEA and CalRecycle.
