Summary of Request: This is a request that the Acting Chief take action on a proposed Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Potrero Hills Compostable Materials Handling Facility, SWIS No. 48-AA-0084, located in Solano County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was received on December 6, 2011. A new proposed permit was received on January 13, 2012. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than March 14, 2012. If no action is taken by March 14, 2012, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed revised permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Acting Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. The required CEQA findings have been made. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685, have been made. An Environmental Impact Report was certified by the Solano County Board of Supervisors on June 19, 2009. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachments. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Staff Report.

Acting Chief:

On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Department Staff report, I concur with the issuance of the New Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Potrero Hills Compostable Materials Handling Facility as proposed.
