On March 21, 2014, the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), serving as the solid waste enforcement agency (EA) for San Luis Obispo County, received your registration permit application to change the existing Small Volume Construction and Demolition/Inert Debris Processing Operation to a Medium Volume Transfer/Processing Facility which will allow the facility to receive up to 99 tons per day of construction and demolition/inert debris and green material. No other changes were proposed.

The registration permit application was deemed complete and correct and accepted for filing on April 7, 2014. Enclosed is the registration permit and accepted application for the facility, issued on April 11, 2014. A copy of the Registration Permit shall be maintained at the facility's office. Any change in design or operation at the facility is subject to review by the EA before implementation.

Additionally, please be advised that nothing in Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Article 6.0 et seq. shall be construed as relieving the owner, operator, or designee from complying with any other local, state, and federal permits, licenses, or other requirements.
