Action By: August 31, 2011

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed modified Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Berkeley Solid Waste Management Transfer Station, SWIS No. 01-AC-0029, located in the City of Berkeley. The Department serves as the Enforcement Agency in this jurisdiction. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The application for the permit modification was received on March 1, 2011. The operator provided a waiver of time until August 31, 2011. A proposed permit was finalized on August 15, 2011. Action must be taken on the proposed permit no later than August 31, 2011. If no action is taken by August 31, 2011, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action:

On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report, I concur in the issuance of the Modified Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Berkeley Solid Waste Management Transfer Station as proposed.
