

Decision Subject: Concurrence on Modified Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the City of Redding Transfer Station, Material Recovery Facility and Composting Facility, SWIS No. 49-AA-0059

Action By: February 3, 2012

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the City of Redding Transfer Station, Material Recovery Facility and Composting Facility, SWIS No. 49-AA-0059, located in Shasta County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was received on October 16, 2012. New permits were received on November 13, 2012 and December 5, 2012. Action must be taken on this permit no later than February 3, 2012. If no action is taken by February 3, 2012, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed modified SWFP.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance staff report, I concur in the issuance of the Modified Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the City of Redding Transfer Station, Material Recovery Facility and Composting Facility, SWIS No. 49-AA-0059, as proposed.
