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12. Legal Description of Facility:

1044 W. Washington Avenue Escondido, CA 92025; Assessor Parcel Numbers 2282507700.

13. Findings:

- a) A County-wide Integrated Waste Management Plan was approved by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) in March, 2011. Pursuant to Public Resources Code (PRC) §50001(b), this facility is not required to comply with PRC §50001. This facility is not a disposal facility, a transformation facility, or an EMSW conversion facility, nor a facility which is designed to recover for reuse or recycling at least 5 percent of the total volume of material received by the facility.
- b) The LEA has determined that the design of the facility would allow for the facility operations to be conducted in compliance with State Minimum Standards for Transfer/Processing Operations and Facilities, based on a review of the July 2015 Transfer Processing Report and an inspection conducted on September 11, 2015.
- c) This permit is consistent with standards adopted by the CalRecycle. Public Resources Code, §44010.
- d) The LEA has reviewed and considered the information, including the environmental effects of issuing this Solid Waste Facility Permit for the existing materials recovery facility for commingled and source separated recyclables. The LEA finds that there are no significant environmental effects arising out of the issuance of this Solid Waste Facility Permit.

15. Prohibitions:

The permittee is prohibited from accepting anything other than commingled/source separated recyclable materials.

16. LEA Conditions:

- a) The operator shall comply with all the State Minimum Standards for solid waste handling.
- b) The operator shall maintain a copy of this permit, Transfer Processing Report (TPR), and a copy of or access to State Minimum Standards for Transfer/Processing Stations at all times.
- c) Without prior written or verbal approval from the LEA to allow otherwise, the facility may only operate as described in the most current version of the TPR.
- d) The permit is subject to review by the LEA and may be temporarily suspended or revoked at any time by the LEA for sufficient cause, in accordance with Division 30 of the PRC, Part 4, Chapter 4, Article 2, Section 44305 et seq.
- e) Any change that would cause the design or operation of the facility not to conform to the terms and conditions of this permit is prohibited. Such change may be considered a significant change, requiring a permit revision. In no case shall the operator implement changes without first submitting a written notice of the proposed change, in the form of a Report of Facility Information amendment, to the LEA at least 180 days in advance of the proposed change.
- f) Stored recyclables shall not interfere with facility operations or cause a public health nuisance as determined by the LEA. The LEA reserves the right to reduce the maximum storage time of recyclables as necessary to protect health

or prevent a nuisance.

- g) If the proposed dust control measures described in the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) fail to adequately control dust from the operation of this facility, the LEA may require that additional measures be implemented.
- h) The operator shall maintain, and keep current, records of the types and weights of materials received per day. These records shall include the final disposition of transferred residual waste and recycled materials.
- i) The residual waste amount is calculated on a monthly basis based on the number of operating days by measuring the outgoing tonnage after separated for reuse materials have been removed.
- j) The amount of putrescible wastes in the separated for reuse material shall be less than 1% of the amount of separated for reuse material received by weight. The putrescible waste in the separated for reuse material shall not cause a nuisance as determined by the LEA.
- k) Additional information related to compliance with this permit or the design and operation of this facility shall be furnished to the LEA upon request.
