Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed Modified Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Shafter Wasco Recycling & Sanitary Landfill, Kern County, SWIS No. 15-AA-0057

Action By: April 24, 2015

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Shafter Wasco Recycling & Sanitary Landfill, SWIS No. 15-AA-0057, located in Kern County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was initially received on January 29, 2016. A new proposed permit was received on February 18, 2016 and February 24, 2016. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than April 24, 2016. If no action is taken by April 24, 2016 the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance staff report, I concur in the issuance of the Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Shafter Wasco Recycling & Sanitary Landfill, SWIS No. 15-AA-0057 as proposed.
