Summary of Request: This is a request that the Acting Branch Chief approve the issuance of a Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit for the Century Nationwide, Inc., TPID No. 1656423, located in Yuba County.

Staff received an application for a Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit on September 17, 2011. The application was accepted on October 17, 2011. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than April 14, 2012.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit application package, staff recommends issuance of the permit. The applicant has met all the necessary application requirements outlined in Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 18431 pertaining to the issuance of a Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit. The documents and analysis on which staff's findings are based are in the facility file.
