18 TO THE RESPONDENT, FREEDOM TIRE INC. You are hereby notified that
19 before an Administrative Law Judge a trial shall be held on **March 12 and 13, 2013, at**
20 **9:00 a.m. at Office of Administrative Hearings, 320 W. Fourth Street, Suite 630,**
21 **Los Angeles, California 90013,** or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard,
22 upon the charges made in the Statement of Issues for the Denial of the Minor Waste
23 Tire Facility Permit served upon you. If you object to the place of hearing, you must
24 notify the presiding officer within 10 days after this notice is served on you. Failure to
25 notify the presiding officer within 10 days will deprive you of a change in the place of the
26 hearing. You may be present at the hearing. You have the right to be represented by
27 an attorney at your own expense. You are not entitled to the appointment of an attorney
28 to represent you at public expense. You are entitled to represent yourself without legal
counsel. You may present any relevant evidence, and will be given full opportunity to

1 cross-examine witnesses testifying at hearing against you. You are entitled to the
2 issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of
3 books, documents, or other things by applying to the Office of Administrative Hearings,
4 320 W. Fourth Street, Suite 630, Los Angeles, California 90013. Pursuant to section
5 11513 of the Government Code, parties are entitled, upon request, to be provided with
6 the assistance of an interpreter if they do not proficiently speak or understand the
7 English language. If you require the assistance of an interpreter; timely notice of this
8 fact should be given to the agency conducting the hearing so that appropriate
9 arrangements can be made.

10 CONTINUANCES: Continuances are not favored. If you need a continuance, write or
11 call immediately to the Office of Administrative Hearings, 320 W. Fourth Street, Suite
12 630, Los Angeles, California 90013, telephone number (213) 576-7200. That agency
13 has control of continuances. Requests coming less than 30 days before hearing, or a
14 request without good cause, will be denied.
