Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) staff have completed our review of the New Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit (Permit) application package, dated November 25, 2014, for Gilton Resource Recovery Transfer Facility, Inc, located at 800 S. McClure Road, in the City of Modesto. The Permit application package was received by CalRecycle staff on December 10, 2014.
