Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) staff have completed our review of the Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit application package, dated and submitted as follows, for TireCore International, LTD, to be located at 11824 Hamden Place in Santa Fe Springs, CA:

- Waste Tire Facility Permit Application (CalRecycle 500), dated April 12, 2016 and submitted May 3, 2016;
- Waste Tire Facility Operation Plan (CalRecycle 501), dated April 5, 2016 and submitted May 3, 2016;
- Waste Tire Facility Environmental Information (CalRecycle 502), dated April 7, 2016 and submitted May 3, 2016;
- Waste Tire Facility Emergency Response Plan (CalRecycle 503), submitted May 27, 2016;
- Tire Storage Plan, tentatively approved by Brian Reparuk of the Santa Fe Springs Department of Fire Rescue Fire Prevention Bureau on April 26, 2016, subject to field inspection; and
- Fire Safety and Evacuation Plan, tentatively approved by Brian Reparuk of the Santa Fe Springs Department of Fire Rescue Fire Prevention Bureau on April 26, 2016, subject to field inspection.

The permit application package was initially received by CalRecycle on May 3, 2016 with amendments received on May 23, 2016 (new Business Tax Certificate with an expiration date of June 30, 2017) and May 27, 2016 (revised Emergency Response Plan, CalRecycle Form 503). CalRecycle staff have determined that the application package conforms to applicable requirements of Title 14, California Code of Regulations (14 CCR), Section 18423(b), and are accepting the application package as complete and correct.

Within 180 days of accepting a complete and correct application package, CalRecycle staff will determine whether to issue or deny a permit pursuant to 14 CCR Section 18425.
