

Decision Subject: Concurrence on a Major Waste Tire Storage Facility Permit for Waste Recovery West, San Joaquin County

Action By: October 12, 2010

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Program Director approve the issuance of a Major Waste Tire Storage Facility Permit for Waste Recovery West, San Joaquin County – Facility No. 39-TI-1538, TPID No. 1608939. Staff’s findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

Staff received an application for a Major Waste Tire Facility Permit on February 11, 2010. The application was accepted on April 15, 2010. CalRecycle is required to act by October 12, 2010.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends issuance of the permit. The applicant has met all the necessary application requirements outlined in 14 CCR, section 18431 pertaining to the issuance of a Major Waste Tire Facility Permit. The required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. The documents and analysis on which staff’s findings are based are in the facility file.
