Decision Subject: Awards and Distribution of Payments for the Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program (California Beverage Container Recycling Fund, FY 2014–15)

Action By: August 31, 2015

Summary of Request:

Staff requests approval of payments for the Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program (CCPP). The funding available for fiscal year 2014–15 is \$10,500,000. Incorporated areas of a city, city and county, or the unincorporated area of a county (as reported by the California Department of Finance’s annual population report (*E-1 Cities, Counties, and the State Population Estimates with Annual Percent Change*)) are eligible to receive funding. Jurisdictions receive funding on a per capita basis, or a minimum of \$5,000 for cities and \$10,000 for counties, whichever is greater. All funds shall be available for expenditure until June 30, 2017, and are subject to annual reporting requirements beginning July 2015.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of 507 awards as listed in Table 1.

Background and Findings:

Statutory Authority

Pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 14581(a)(3)(A) of the California Beverage Container Recycling and Litter Reduction Act, CalRecycle is authorized to expend \$10,500,000 annually for payments to cities and counties for beverage container recycling and litter clean-up activities. Payments are calculated on a per capita basis, with a minimum payment of \$5,000 to cities and \$10,000 to counties.

Program Background

The CCPP provides annual funding to California cities and counties for beverage container recycling projects that assist in achieving an 80 percent recycling rate for the state.

Criteria and Process

On March 19, 2015, the Notice of Funds Available was emailed to 539 eligible jurisdictions. The deadline to submit the Funding Request was June 23, 2015.

CalRecycle received and reviewed 507 Funding Requests by the due date. Funding Requests were not submitted by the 32 jurisdictions identified in Table 2. These funds, totaling \$271,864 were redistributed among the 507 jurisdictions based on population and will be distributed in September 2015. All funds shall be available for expenditure until June 30, 2017, and are subject to annual reporting requirements beginning July 2015.
