The purpose of this workshop is to continue to discuss possible regulatory changes within the covered electronic waste (CEW) recycling program. The focus is expected to be limited to requirements, restrictions, and allowances for the management and ultimate disposition of residual CRT glass derived from processed (cancelled) CEW.

The format for the workshop will feature CalRecycle staff providing an overview of the workshop topic and a recap of regulatory concepts presented at previous workshops. This will be followed by draft regulatory language and open discussion. The workshop will allow stakeholders to comment, question, and discuss the rationale and possible evolution of the CEW recycling payment system.
