




California Statewide Per Capita

Per Capita Disposal


The official metric for jurisdiction numerical compliance with the 50% mandate.


Statewide Population & Employment




Recycling Rate

75% Statewide Recycling Goal by 2020.


Assembly Bill 341 (2011)
