Subject: Approval of the Beneficial Reuse of Waste Tires as Crash Barriers at Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca, Monterey County, TPID No. 1316562

Dear Mr. Brady:

On August 23, 2016, the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) received your request for approval of the beneficial reuse of waste tires in the construction of crash barriers at Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca, located in the City of Salinas, Monterey County. Your request included information regarding the beneficial use of waste tires in crash barriers to reduce potential harm to race participants and the machinery without causing negative impacts to public health and safety or the environment. CalRecycle staff have determined that the use of waste tires as crash barriers at the Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca facility qualifies as a beneficial reuse pursuant to Title 14, California Code of Regulations (14 CCR), Sections 17346(f) and 18431.3. As an approved beneficial use, the waste tires used as crash barriers will not be determined to be stored or disposed and use does not require the issuance of a Waste Tire Facility Permit from CalRecycle.

Please note that if the beneficial use of waste tires is discontinued, Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca or the legal operator and/or business owner and/or land owner is fully responsible for the removal and the proper recycling or disposal of the waste tires in a manner consistent with the waste tire laws and regulations. In addition, this approval applies to the waste tires that are being used as crash barriers in the beneficial use cited and does not entitle the storage beyond the regulatory limit of 499 waste tires without further authorization (i.e., Waste Tire Facility Permit).

CalRecycle staff or their authorized agents are authorized by regulation to inspect and/or carry out investigations at the Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca facility to determine continued compliance with requirements of 14 CCR Section 17346(f) and 18431.3 for the beneficial use of the waste tires as well as other applicable waste tire laws and regulations.
