FOR THE LAMB CANYON LANDFILL SOLID WASTE FACILITY PERMIT REVISION RECEIVED BY RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH, AS THE LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY (LEA)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Waste Management Department has submitted an application to revise the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the Lamb Canyon Sanitary Landfill, (SWIS 33-AA-0007), received by the Riverside County LEA which was reviewed and found to be **Complete and Correct on March 6, 2015**. This application includes:

- An updated Joint Technical Document (JTD) #18 Report of Facilities Information (RFI)
- Revised Days of Operation to include Sunday
- Proposing changes to the leachate recirculation system
- Revisions to the Total Design Capacity, Maximum Final Elevation, Maximum Depth
- Proposed Accepting Additional Waste Types and Updating the list of Recent Site Improvements
- Revised Estimated Final Closure Date of 2029
- Updating JTD # 19 the Preliminary Closure and Post Closure Maintenance Plan (PCPCMP)
- Revisions to the Non-Water Release Corrective action Cost Estimate
