

Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Puente Hills Materials Recovery Facility, Los Angeles County, SWIS No. 19-AA-1043

Action By: November 23, 2013

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed Revised Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Puente Hills Materials Recovery Facility (PHMRF), SWIS No. 19-AA-1043, located in Los Angeles County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was initially received on August 30, 2013. New proposed permits were received on September 12, 2013 and September 24, 2013. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than November 23, 2013. If no action is taken by November 23, 2013, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the attached Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report, I concur in the issuance of the Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Puente Hills Material Recovery Facility, SWIS No. 19-AA-1043, as proposed.
