Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Pena's Disposal, Inc. Transfer Station & Material Recovery Facility, Tulare County, SWIS No. 54-AA-0034

Action By: July 20, 2015

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed revised Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Pena's Disposal, Inc. Transfer Station & Material Recovery Facility, SWIS No. 54-AA-0034, located in Tulare County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was received on April 29, 2015. A new proposed permit was received on May 21, 2015. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than July 20, 2015. If no action is taken by July 20, 2015, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by the Integrated Waste Management Act (IWMA), including those set out in Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 21685 have been made. The Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) was certified and a Statement of Overriding Considerations was adopted by the Tulare County Board of Supervisors on October 14, 2014. The FEIR identified unavoidable significant impacts to Noise Resources. These findings are summarized in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The Department's findings required under CEQA and staff's analysis and recommendations are set out in the attached Staff Report. The documents on which staff's findings are based are contained in the facility files.

Branch Chief Action: I certify that I have reviewed and considered the information in the prepared environmental documents for this proposed Revised Solid Waste Facilities Permit, including without limitation the environmental effects of the project as described in the FEIR. I adopt as the Department's own the findings made by the Tulare County Resource Management Agency, Environmental Planning Division, acting as Lead Agency, as required by CEQA Guidelines Section 15091. I adopt as the Department's own the Statement of Overriding Considerations adopted by the Tulare County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15093.

Therefore, on the basis of the information, analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report, I concur in the issuance of the Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Pena's Disposal, Inc. Transfer Station & Material Recovery Facility, SWIS No. 54-AA-0034 as proposed.
