

Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed New Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Athens Sun Valley MRF, SWIS No. 19-AR-5581

Action By: August 16, 2010

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Director take action on a proposed New Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Athens Sun Valley MRF, SWIS No. 19-AR-5581, located in the City of Los Angeles. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was received on June 15, 2010. Action must be taken on this permit no later than August 16, 2010. If no action is taken by August 16, 2010, the Director will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit. Note: The Temporary permit will expire on June 30, 2010.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Deputy Director concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. The Final Environmental Impact Report (the "EIR") which was certified on February 1, 2010 by the LEA and re-certified on June 24, 2010. CEQA Findings, a Statement of Overriding Considerations and a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program were adopted by the LEA on June 24, 2010. The Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was certified and a Statement of Overriding Considerations was adopted by the Los Angeles Local Enforcement Agency on June 24, 2010. The EIR identified significant and unavoidable environmental impacts due to Air Quality and Traffic. These findings are summarized in the Waste Compliance and Mitigation Program Staff Report. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the Waste Compliance and Mitigation Program Staff Report.

Director Action:


