Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed New Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Livermore Sanitation Recyclable Materials Transload Facility, SWIS No. 01-AA-0301

Action By: March 17, 2013

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed new Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit, for the Livermore Sanitation Recyclable Materials Transload Facility, SWIS No. 01-AA-0301, located in Alameda County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was initially received on November 1, 2012. New proposed permits were received on November 26, 2012, December 26, 2012, January 9, 2013 and January 16, 2013. Action must be taken on this permit no later than March 17, 2013. If no action is taken by March 17, 2013, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed new permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report, I concur in the issuance of the New Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Livermore Sanitation Recyclable Materials Transload Facility, No. 01-AA-0301, as proposed.
