**3660 Dalbergia Street (Lots 5 through 22, A & B, Block 262 of Guions Addition, Map No. 220),
Barrio Logan Community Plan Area, San Diego, San Diego County, CA 92113
Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 2 West, SBBM**

13. Findings:

- a) Pursuant to Public Resources Code §50001 (b), this solid waste facility is a material recovery facility and transfer station that is not designed to recover for reuse or recycling at least 5 percent of the total volume of materials received by the facility, and therefore is not required to comply with the requirements of Public Resources Code §50001. The facility is identified in the City of San Diego Non Disposal Facility Element (September 2008).
- b) This permit is consistent with standards adopted by CalRecycle, pursuant to PRC §44010.
- c) The LEA has determined that the design and operation of the facility is in compliance with the State Minimum Standards for Solid Waste Handling and Disposal, based on a review of the January 2014 Transfer Processing Report (TPR) and an inspection of the facility conducted on March 11, 2014.
- d) The LEA has reviewed and considered the information contained in the Negative Declaration (SCH# 2003071067) dated August 25, 2003, prepared by the City of San Diego and adopted by the Hearing Officer of the City of San Diego on August 27, 2003, and finds that there are no significant unmitigatable environmental effects arising out of the issuance of this Solid Waste Facility Permit. A Notice of Determination was posted by the San Diego County Clerk on September 8, 2003.

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The operator shall maintain, and keep current, a record including, but not limited to, fires, explosions, significant injuries, accidents, or property damage.

The operator shall maintain, and keep current, a record of the quantities and the types of hazardous wastes, medical wastes, or otherwise prohibited wastes found in the waste stream and the disposition of these materials.

UPON REQUEST**LEA****16. LEA Conditions:**

- a) The permittee is prohibited from accepting any liquid waste sludge, non-hazardous waste requiring special handling, designated waste, hazardous wastes, biohazardous wastes, waste containing more than 50% water, friable and non-friable asbestos, dead animals, and radioactive wastes.
- b) The operator shall maintain, and keep current, records of weight and types of waste received per day. These records shall include the final disposition of transferred waste and recycled materials.
- c) The operator shall maintain, and keep current, a record of the number and types of vehicles using the facility per day.
- d) Stored recyclables shall not interfere with facility operations or cause a public health nuisance as determined by the LEA. The LEA reserves the right to reduce the maximum storage time of recyclables necessary to protect the public health and safety or prevent a nuisance.
- e) The operator shall maintain a complete copy of this Solid Waste Facility Permit, Transfer Processing Report, and State Minimum Standards for Transfer/Processing Station at the site at all times.
- f) Any change that would cause the design or operation of the facility not to conform to the terms and conditions of this permit is prohibited. Such a change may be considered a significant change, requiring a permit revision. In no case shall the operator implement any change without first submitting a written notice of the proposed change, in the form of an RFI amendment, to the EA at least 180 days in advance of the change.
- g) Additional information related to compliance with this permit or information concerning the design and operation of this facility shall be furnished to the LEA upon request.
- h) The Solid Waste Facility Permit is subject to review by the LEA and may be suspended or revoked at any time for sufficient cause, in accordance with Division 30 of the PRC, Part 4, Article 2, Sections 44305 et seq. and associated regulations
- i) If the proposed dust control system, odor control system, or track out of waste control system fails to be adequate for the control of dust, odor, or track out residual during the operations of the facility, the LEA may require additional measures be enacted.
- j) The LEA reserves the right to suspend or modify waste receiving and handling operations due to an emergency, a potential health hazard, or the creation of a public nuisance.
