



Greenhouse Gas Reduction Programs Workshop

Funding

Governor's Proposed Budget Allocates \$25 Million

- ~\$20 M to Grants
- ~\$5 M to Loans

CalRecycle Proposed Grants Allocation

- ~\$15 M to Organics (\$3 M max)
 - \$2 M for Rurals (\$1 M max)
- \$5 M to Recycled Fiber, Plastic & Glass (\$2.5 M max)

Disadvantaged Communities

CalEnviroScreen 2.0

- Communities subject to highest environmental burdens and containing most vulnerable populations

SB 535, GHG Reduction Fund

- Communities scoring in the top 25% in CES 2.0 (76th – 100th percentile)

Disadvantaged Communities

Data Required for DAC Form

- Location of Processing Facilities
- Location of Landfill from which Material will be Diverted
- Food Waste Prevention Component
 - Location of food rescue organization facility
 - Location of communities served by food rescue organization
- Location includes address, community/city name, zip code, and census tract, score percentile
- Jobs
 - Location of DAC communities being provided jobs

Disadvantaged Communities

DAC Scoring Criteria

- Composting facility located in DAC and results in direct air and/or water quality benefits in the DAC
- Digestion facility is located in DAC
- Majority of waste is diverted from landfill(s) located in DAC
- Food rescue project increases food access to residents of DAC
- Provide specified percentage of jobs to residents of DAC

Data Available on SB 535 Interactive Map

- Score Percentile (DAC = Top 25% or 76-100 percentile)
- Zip Code
- Census Tracts

Loan Cycle 1 (FY14-15) - Food and/or Green Waste only

Application Release: November 2014

Applications Received: Two

Funds Available: \$4,662,000

Funds Requested: \$1,740,000

Funds Remaining: **\$2,922,000**

Loan Cycle 2 (FY14-15) - Food, Green Waste, Recycled Fiber, Plastics or Glass Materials

Application Release: April 1, 2015

Applicant Approval: First-come, first-served basis

Funds Available: **\$2,922,000** until depleted or June 2015

Loans

FY 2015-16

Food, Green Waste, Recycled Fiber, Plastics or Glass Materials

- One Loan cycle will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis
- Application Release – late April/early May 2015
- Applications Due – early Summer 2015
- Funds Available: \$4,662,000
until depleted or June 2016

Subject to approval of the 2015/16 State Budget, typically July 2015.
