I have received and considered your agency's June 30, 2011 request to extend the compliance schedule by an additional twelve months beyond the two year period previously granted by the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for the American Avenue Landfill, a facility on the Inventory of Solid Waste Facilities Which Violate Statement Minimum Standards. I hereby approve your request for the extension of the compliance schedule until October 13, 2013.

CalRecycle staff are encouraged by the corrective measures the owner/operator put forth since the issuance of the notice and order on November 2, 2010. Staff also commends the LEA for its continued diligence in pursuing that the violation is corrected and that full compliance with the applicable state minimum standard is achieved.
