I have received and considered your agency's November 8, 2013 request to extend the compliance schedule by an additional twelve months beyond the extended compliance date previously granted by the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for the American Avenue Landfill, a facility on the Inventory of Solid Waste Facilities Which Violate Statement Minimum Standards. I acknowledge the extenuating circumstances the operator has encountered by losing their contractor and acknowledge that the additional work required to expand the Landfill Gas System will take time. I hereby approve your request for the extension of the compliance schedule until October 13, 2014.
