SUBJECT: Approval for a 6th Extension of the Compliance Schedule for the West Central Landfill, Facility No. 45-AA-0043, Shasta County

Dear Ms. Serio:

I have received and considered your agency's August 22, 2016 request to extend the compliance schedule by an additional 12 months beyond the one year period previously granted by the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for the West Central Landfill, a facility on the Inventory of Solid Waste Facilities Which Violate Statement Minimum Standards.

Title 14, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 18365 provides that CalRecycle may grant a one-year extension beyond the two years of inclusion on the Inventory upon the completion of three milestones.

CalRecycle acknowledges that statistical analysis of gas monitoring logs demonstrates a continued significant downward trend in methane concentrations in the two remaining non-compliant monitoring probes.

Therefore, I hereby approve your request for the extension of the compliance schedule until **August 25, 2017** on the condition that your agency require the operator to increase monitoring frequency of non-compliant perimeter monitoring probes from *quarterly to monthly* in order to better assess the need for a new remediation plan.

Future extensions will not be granted without a demonstration of good faith effort, extenuating circumstances, and submittal of a new remediation plan if there is not a demonstrated continued downward trend in methane concentrations in the two remaining non-compliant monitoring probes.

Within 30 days of receipt of this approval, please forward to CalRecycle a copy of the updated compliance schedule which includes milestone dates designed to monitor progress and ensure that compliance is achieved in a timely manner.
