Dear Chair Callaway,

After carefully considering all of the testimony of witnesses, all documents and other matters related to the August 20, 2013 Public Hearing to consider the issuance of Compliance Order No. IWMA BR 09-003 (Compliance Order) for Calaveras County Regional Agency (County), the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) has determined that placing the County on a Compliance Order is consistent with statute. The Department has approved the Compliance Order. For your reference, attached is a signed copy of both the Request for Action and the Compliance Order.

According to the Compliance Order's schedule, the County is to work with CalRecycle staff to determine gaps in program areas and develop a Local Implementation Plan (LIP) to improve, expand, or implement new diversion programs. I directed my staff to contact County staff by next week to schedule a meeting. The County shall develop and submit to CalRecycle a fully executed LIP no later than December 31, 2013.
