

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING

Regarding the pending revision to the L&D Landfill Solid Waste Facility Permit

Background: The current L and D Landfill Solid Waste Facility Permit (34-AA-0020) allows the landfilling of waste consisting primarily of construction and demolition debris and inert waste and transfer processing/material recovery operations. On October 22, 2014, the operator submitted an application to EMD to revise the current permit to allow on-site processing of green waste. The application was accepted as incomplete on November 21, 2014 pending submittal of additional information and was accepted as complete and correct on May 20, 2015.

Purpose of Meeting: To provide information to the public regarding the proposed, Revised Solid Waste Facility Permit, pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations (14CCR), Section 21660 et seq. Additional information will be provided regarding the environmental review, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), currently in progress.

EMD is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the Cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA enforces state solid waste laws and regulations at landfills as well as other types of solid waste facilities. The LEA is also the lead agency for CEQA for the proposed project.

Project Description:

The Applicant proposes changes to the facility Solid Waste Facility Permit that would allow the following design and operations:

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Acceptance and on-site processing of green waste, including curbside collected green waste, to use as alternative daily cover (ADC). Title 27, section 20690 allows use of ADC in lieu of soil to cover landfilled waste on a daily basis. Section 20690(b)(3) provides for the use of processed green waste as ADC. The facility currently accepts green waste for ADC that is pre-processed at another facility. Additionally, L and D Landfill currently accepts green waste for disposal and for off-site transfer within 48 hours of receipt. The project would potentially increase the amount of green waste coming into the facility for ADC and other uses from the current 70 tons per day to 250 tons per day with 400 ton per day peaks, not to exceed 6500 tons per month. The facility's operating document is also being revised to address installation of 6 solar arrays and relocation of the material recovery operations pad in 2016 due to phased landfill closure.
