## PUBLIC NOTICE

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PROJECT NAME: Visalia Disposal Site

Visalia Disposal Site is a 631 acre Landfill located at 8614 Avenue 328, Visalia, California.

On April 30, 2014 Tulare County LEA received for review the RDSI/JTD application. Tulare County Solid Waste Department has proposed to amend their existing Report of Disposal Site Information/Joint Technical Document. The proposed changes are the following:

- A new ancillary facility has been added. The ancillary facility has been described as a “recyclable materials transload facility (RMTF)” to be located at the north end of the existing old cotton gin building located northwest of the entrance to the facility.
- The facility will be operated under a Medium Volume Transfer/Processing Facility by a third party contracting with the City of Visalia to transfer their recyclables off-site for processing at the Pena’s Disposal Transfer Station and Material Recovery Facility in Cutler, Ca. The facility will only receive up to 100 tons per day.

On May 29, 2015, Tulare County LEA:

(1) found that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents in that no subsequent EIR or Negative Declaration or supplemental EIR is warranted pursuant to Title 14, Chapter 3, Article 11, §§15162 or 15163, or finds the change being requested is exempt from the requirements of CEQA pursuant to Title 14, Chapter 3, Article 5, §§15060 and 15061;

(2) has deemed the proposed change acceptable and consistent with, but not limited to, State minimum standards pursuant to Chapter 3 of this subdivision or applicable minimum standards in Title 14 (commencing with §17200), and including financial assurances and operating liability criteria pursuant to Chapter 6 of this subdivision if applicable; and

(3) Finds the changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit.

Documents are available for public review by appointment only at the Tulare County LEA office located at 5957 S. Mooney Blvd., Visalia, California, 93277.
