Introduction

Please be advised that the County of Sacramento Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved an Amendment to the Report of Facility Information (RFI) for the Waste Management Recycling America, dba K & M Recycling. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County and City of Sacramento.

Description of project and LEA's determination

LEA staff received an application package to amend the Waste Management Recycling America, dba K & M Recycling RFI on December 16, 2015. The application was accepted by the LEA on December 22, 2015. The amendment to the RFI was submitted in response to the Five Year Permit Review Report issued on September 01, 2015. The changes to the RFI include descriptions of the current status, occasional operations, and the storage of recyclable materials at the facility; an update to the site map; an update to the Fire Prevention Plan; an update to the location of maintaining records consistent with permit conditions; and an update to the facility's maintenance program. In addition to these updates, the RFI amendment is comprised of the City of Sacramento Fire Department's approval letter of the facility's Fire Prevention Plan.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 27 (27 CCR), Section 21665, the LEA approved and filed the amendment to the RFI, without a revision to the permit, based upon the following criteria:

- 1) The proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified CEQA documents;
- 2) The proposed changes are acceptable and consistent with, but not limited to, state minimum standards, pursuant to 27 CCR and 14 CCR; and
- 3) The changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current SWFP.
