

Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Shafter Wasco Landfill, SWIS No. 15-AA-0057

Action By: April 3, 2010

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Director take action on a proposed Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Shafter Wasco Landfill, SWIS No. 15-AA-0057, located in Kern County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.


The proposed permit was received on November 30, 2009, and an amended proposed permit was received on February 2, 2010. Action must be taken on this permit no later than April 2, 2010. If no action is taken by April 2, 2010, the Director will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Director concur with the issuance of the permit and sign below. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Waste Compliance and Mitigation Program Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the Waste Compliance and Mitigation Program Staff Report.

Deputy Director Action: I have reviewed and considered the information contained in the Final Environmental Impact Report ("FEIR") prepared for this proposed solid waste facilities permit or the project of which this proposed permit is a part, including the environmental effects of the project as described in the FEIR.

On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Department staff report, I adopt as the Department's own the CEQA Findings and Statement of Overriding Considerations adopted by the Kern County Board of Supervisors for this project and I concur in the issuance of the Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Shafter Wasco Landfill as proposed.
