Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Contra Costa Transfer and Recovery Station, SWIS No. 07-AA-0027

Action By: January 17, 2012

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Contra Costa Transfer and Recovery Station, SWIS No. 07-AA-0027, located in Contra Costa County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was received on November 18, 2011. A previous proposed permit was received on September 28, 2011. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than January 17, 2012. If no action is taken by January 17, 2012, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed revised permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. Required CEQA findings have been made. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685, have not been made. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was adopted by the Contra Costa Environmental Health Service Director on April 7, 2011. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachments. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action:

On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Department Staff report, I concur with the issuance of the Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Contra Costa Transfer and Recovery Station as proposed.
