North SLO County Recycling, SWIS No. 40-AA-0040

Action By: January 7, 2014

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a Registration Permit for North SLO County Recycling, SWIS No. 40-AA-0040, located in San Luis Obispo County. The subject facility is an existing Small Volume Green Material Chipping and Grinding Operation authorized to accept up to 200 tons per day of green material under an EA Notification, dated January 23, 2004. The operator submitted an application for a Registration Permit as a Medium Volume Transfer/Processing Facility to accept up to 99 tons per day of green material and green material commingled with food material. The materials received will be chipped and ground and hauled directly to the operator's compost facility in Creston, San Luis Obispo County. The Department serves as the Enforcement Agency in this jurisdiction.

The application for the Medium Volume Transfer/Processing Facility Registration Permit was received on December 16, 2013. The registration permit application was accepted as complete on January 2, 2014. A registration permit is required to be transmitted to the operator five (5) days after the application is accepted or by January 7, 2014.

The public was noticed via posting at the facility and on CalRecycle's website.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief issue the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 14, Section 18104.2 have been made. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in this memorandum, I hereby issue the Registration Permit for North SLO County Recycling as proposed.
