Decision Subject: APPROVAL OF AWARD OF SERVICES CONTRACT FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL INVESTIGATION SERVICES CONTRACT - DRR11055 (INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT ACCOUNT AND SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL TRUST FUND, FYS 2011/12, 2012/13 & 2013/14)

REQUESTED ACTION:

This item requests the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) Waste Permitting, Compliance & Mitigation Division Deputy Director to consider and approve a contractor to provide site investigation and related services to assist in investigation and enforcement of state minimum standards at closed, illegal, and abandoned solid waste disposal sites in California. The contract would expire in May 2014, unless extended, and would be for an amount not to exceed four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) with initial funding proposed at ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) from the mandatory services portion of the Integrated Waste Management Account (IWMA). The current contract expires in May 2012.

Recommendation: Approve the proposed contractor and direct staff to enter into a contract with the awarded contractor.
